**Location \*\*Please note that Lake Houston Marina is no longer available for use as a staging area. Main headquarters will be located along the Texas Adaptive Aquatics Shoreline (same location as 2017). We are working to make shuttling as efficient as possible. Boat Launch is available. \*\***

**Directions**

From US 59 North, head east on FM 1960, travel East 10 miles past City of Humble, cross over McKay Bridge at Lake Houston, and turn right onto Fairlake Lane (first street on the right after crossing the bridge). Follow Fairlake Ln for 1.2 miles and make a right onto Old Atascocita Rd. Trash Bash will be located at the end of the street at the Lakefront.

From US-90E, take 2100 N (Crosby Huffman Rd) for 15 miles and turn left onto Old Atascocita Rd. Follow Old Atascocita Rd for approximately 3 miles. Trash Bash will be located at the end of the street.

**Parking**

On-site parking will be available at the main staging area only.

**Registration Area**

Old Atascocita Rd (Texas Adaptive Aquatics Shorefront / Andy Anderson Park). To register by phone, please call the Trash Bash hotline number (281)-486-9500 and leave a detailed message for the Lake Houston site.

**Area to be Cleaned**

Volunteers will be shuttled (multiple shuttles will be in rotation) to cleanup zones along FM-1960/McKay Bridge waterfront. Other areas accessible by boat are up to the discretion of the individual boat owner. For those with small children, litter may be picked up along the shoreline near the main staging area.

### **Information for Volunteers using their Boat for the Cleanup**

For your convenience, you may launch your boat from the Texas Adaptive Aquatics Boat launch, your subdivision's boat launch, other public launch or marina boat launches (may be subject to a launch fee). Motorized boats, canoes, kayaks and Jon boats or other watercraft may be used although **Trash Bash insurance does not cover boat-related accidents to volunteers, boats or equipment.**

Please either register in advance or fill out a registration form at the main staging area before launching your boat.

After registration, you will be provided hand gloves, trash bags, and safety information. All boats must have all the safety equipment and insurance required by law and all passengers must wear a life jacket. Boat owners are responsible for the conduct, safety and liability of the persons utilizing their boat. Boats should only take volunteers to public areas of the lake accessible by the means available to them. Volunteers should not enter the water to collect trash. Only floatable trash and what can be reached along shorelines should be collected.

Travel to and from a location as well as trash collection should be done only within the time allotted for the collection period for the Trash Bash event.

Volunteers on boats should return to the staging area on Old Atascocita Rd prior to lunch being served.
