Trash Bash Invites Volunteers to Its 31st Annual Cleanup on March 29, 2025
Thousands of volunteers to clean area waterways

The [River, Lakes, Bays 'N Bayous Trash Bash®](#) (Trash Bash®) will celebrate its 31st annual litter cleanup this year, and invites volunteers to come out and “Clean It Like You Mean It !”® on Saturday, March 29, 2025. Trash Bash® is proud of its heritage as the largest, single-day, waterway cleanup in Texas. Over three decades, more than 121,000 volunteers have removed over 2,500 tons of trash, and 12,410 tires from the Galveston Bay watershed.

The cleanup is open to all ages and welcomes individuals, families, scouts, industry, and other groups. Multiple cleanup sites are available across the greater Houston area. A few notable site changes this year include a new site at Mac McGaffey Highland Bayou Park, the Terry Hershey Park site moving to Bear Creek Park, and the Sims Bayou site partnering with Houston Botanic Garden to help clean their stretch of the bayou. Cleanup supplies, event t-shirts and lunch are provided to volunteers, and commemorative patches are available for scouts and collectors.

“We are excited to celebrate the 31st Trash Bash® cleanup with our wonderful volunteers. Whether this is their first cleanup or if they have been joining us for decades, they are the reason Trash Bash® has become such a successful cleanup event helping to keep our waterways clean and beautiful,” said Lori Traweek, president of the nonprofit Texas Conservation Fund, which manages Trash Bash® with administrative support by the Houston-Galveston Area Council, Gulf Coast Authority, and a volunteer steering committee.
