Badge and Journey Requirements Met

Girl Scouts of all levels can complete Badge and Journey requirements. Some of the requirements are more obvious in the trash bash setting. These include:

All:

Girl Scout Way Badge- Step 4 (Leaving a place cleaner than they found it)

Daisy:

Eco-learner Badge- Step 3

Good Neighbor- Step 1

Clover Petal

Brownie

Wonders of Water- Save Water Award

Junior Badge:

Animal Habitats Badge -Step # 5

Agent of Change- Power of Team Award

Cadettes

Eco Trekker Badge- Step 4

Leaders are encouraged to check out the badge requirements for their level to see if they can incorporate additional learning experiences to complete other badge requirements. The Daisy Eco-Learner could easily be earned if leaders have girls discuss how they should be prepared to go outside (step 1). If girl walks along a path during the trash pickup, they earned the badge by completing all 3 steps. For another example, you may see some flowers when you're completing your clean up. If you discuss flowers and their lifecycles, you could earn part of the Junior Flowers Badge. Or, if you see trees and talk about the parts of the tree and the relationship trees have with humans, you could earn part of the Cadette Trees Badge. Other requirements may be met as part of other Journeys or as part of a Take Action project.
